Overview

UP Super TET is Uttar Pradesh's direct recruitment examination for Assistant Teacher posts in Basic Shiksha Parishad primary and upper-primary schools — distinct from UPTET, which is only an eligibility test. Candidates must already hold a valid UPTET (or equivalent) qualification before applying to Super TET, making this the actual merit-based recruitment stage that decides real teaching appointments in UP's vast government primary education system. Selection is based entirely on a single written examination — there's no separate interview stage — with the final merit list and subsequent school allotment based directly on the written exam score.

What's New in the 2026 Cycle

- UPTET (or equivalent) qualification is a mandatory prerequisite before applying — Super TET itself is the actual recruitment exam, not another eligibility test.
- No separate Interview stage — the written exam score alone determines the final merit list and subsequent school allotment.
- Covers General Studies alongside Child Pedagogy and subject knowledge, a broader scope than UPTET's structure.
- Given Uttar Pradesh's vast number of primary schools, Super TET recruitment cycles typically involve very large vacancy counts relative to many other state teaching exams.

Selection Process

- 1 Written Examination — sole basis for merit.
- 2 Merit list preparation based on written exam scores.
- 3 Document Verification and school allotment based on merit-cum-preference.

Salary & Job Profile

UP Super TET-recruited Assistant Teachers are typically placed around Pay Level 6–7 of the UP state pay matrix, plus Dearness Allowance, HRA and other state-specific allowances depending on posting.

Preparation Tips

- Since there's no separate Interview, treat the written exam with the seriousness of a final selection round — every mark counts directly toward your merit rank.
- General Studies and Current Affairs carry real weight beyond UPTET's typical scope — don't neglect this broader General Awareness component.
- Build on your UPTET preparation rather than starting from scratch, since Child Pedagogy and subject-specific content overlap significantly.
- Practise previous years' Super TET papers specifically, since the exam's exact section weightage can differ from UPTET's.

Exam Day Guidelines

- Carry the Admit Card and a valid original photo ID to the exam centre.
- Confirm your UPTET (or equivalent) qualification is valid and current before applying, since it's a mandatory prerequisite.
- Since it's an offline OMR-based exam, carry a black ballpoint pen as specified in the notification.
- No electronic devices are allowed inside the exam hall.

Frequently Asked Questions

What is the difference between UPTET and Super TET?

UPTET is only an eligibility test with no direct job offer, while Super TET is UP's actual merit-based recruitment exam for Assistant Teacher posts — UPTET clearance is typically a prerequisite for applying to Super TET.

Is there an Interview in UP Super TET selection?

No, selection is based entirely on the written exam score, with no separate Interview stage.

Do I need to clear UPTET again before applying to Super TET?

You need a valid, current UPTET (or equivalent recognised TET) qualification at the time of applying to Super TET — check the specific notification for validity requirements.

Is there negative marking in UP Super TET?

This is specified in each notification and should be verified against the current official notice, since it can vary by cycle.
